Who will Phase 1 expansion of the Education Center Building benefit?

The expansion of the Education Center Building as proposed for Phase 1 of the Campus Master Plan will benefit the entire parish community by allowing for increases in programming and attendance in Catholic Education for the youth of our parish through the School and Faith Formation Programs. The children and adults who attend the multi-cultural English as a Second Language Program (ESL) will also benefit from the expanded classroom space.

- The Faith Formation programs serve children from preschool through 5th grade through Sunday School, Sacramental Preparation, and Elementary Religious Education classes. Classes meet on Sundays and also Monday evenings. Almost 500 parish children are currently registered in the program, coming from 34 different area schools, including preschools and kindergartens.
- The ESL program currently has 140 registered participants from a variety of cultures including Hispanic, Asian, Eastern European and African. Approximately 30 volunteers assist with this program which includes child care to facilitate allowing entire families to participate in these important classes. The ESL program uses the Education Center building on Tuesday and Thursday evenings following the regular school year schedule.
